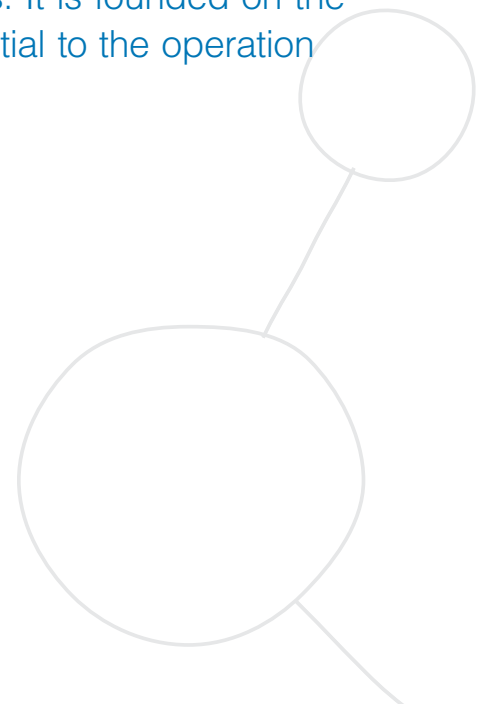


Health and Safety Leadership Centre.
