Through an annual survey of over 3,700 large-cap companies across the globe, the CDP provides investors, policy makers, and businesses with current information on companies' strategies, actions to date, climate change governance arrangements, and best practices. This year's CDP survey was carried out on behalf of 485 large institutional investors, with \$55 trillion in assets under management.

The CDP is the gold standard for carbon disclosure methodology and survey techniques. The CDP website—www.cdproject.net—is the largest repository of corporate greenhouse gas emissions data in the world.

This year's **Carbon Disclosure Project Report 2009—Canada 200** will be made available online on October 8, 2009. At the launch event, attendees will receive the **CDP Report 2009—Global 500**.
