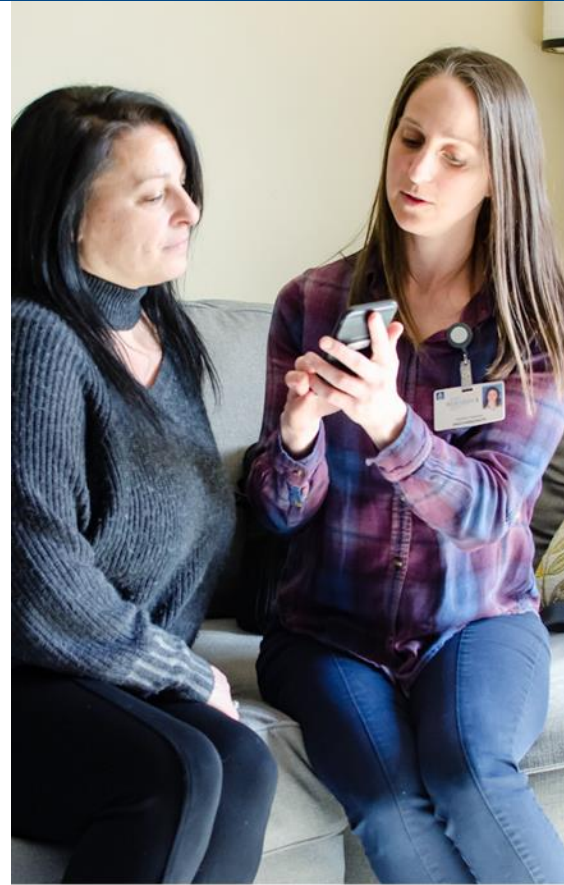

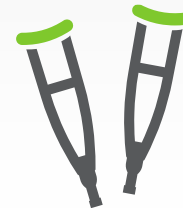

Chatham-Kent Community Paramedicine

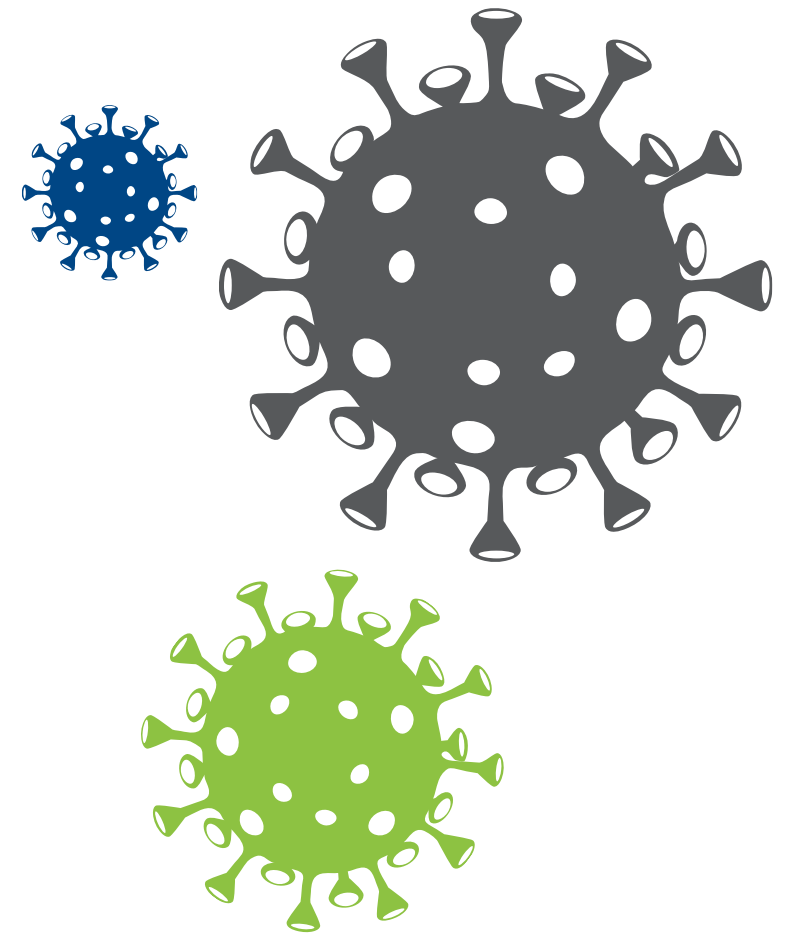
First launched in 2015, the Community Paramedics Improving Patient Outcomes (CPIPO) program provides home-based services to complex patients.

Program evaluations have highlighted an 84% reduction in 911 calls and a 51% reduction in Emergency Department visits for targeted populations.

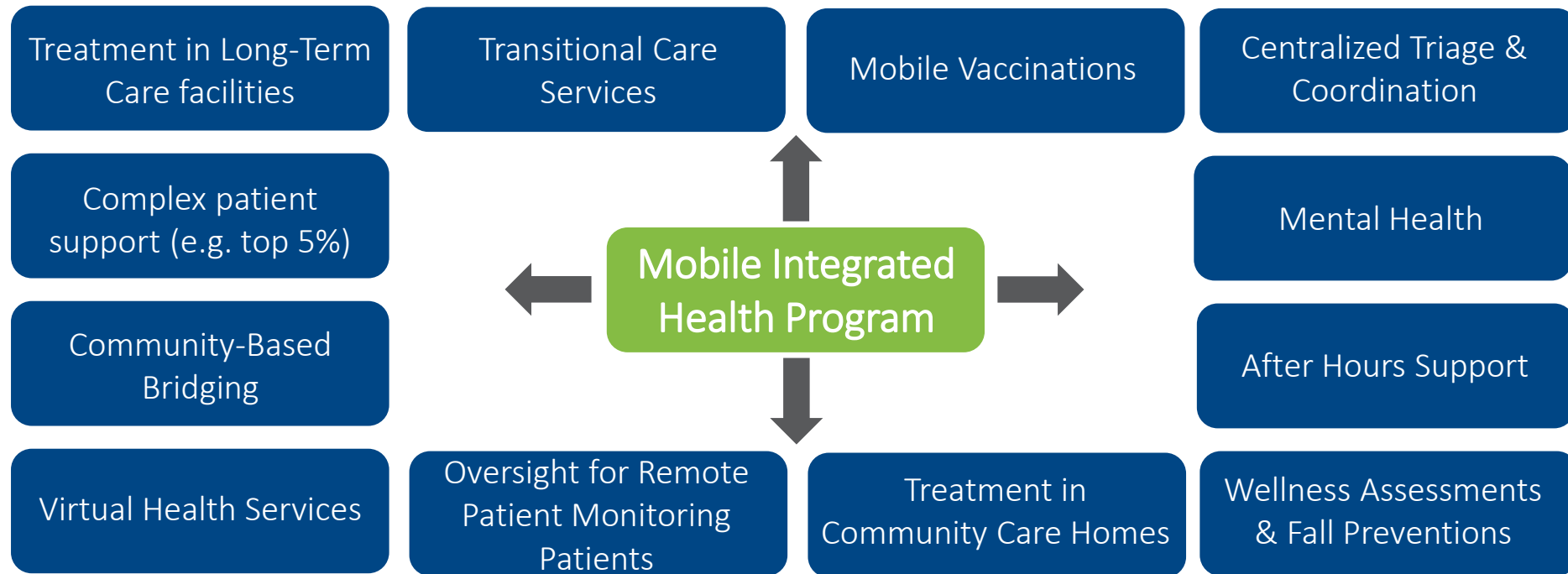


Pivoting Care: COVID-19

- Hospital Decants (bed capacity at 40-50%)
 - ✓ Rapid scope changes
- COVID-19 Screening and Testing

- Vaccination - Pop-Up and Mobile Clinics

- Telemedicine and Remote Patient Monitoring
 - ✓ Supplementing Cough and Fever Clinic work
 - ✓ Supplementing in home visits by telephone
- Surge Capacity – ISC
- System Navigation -811/Telehealth

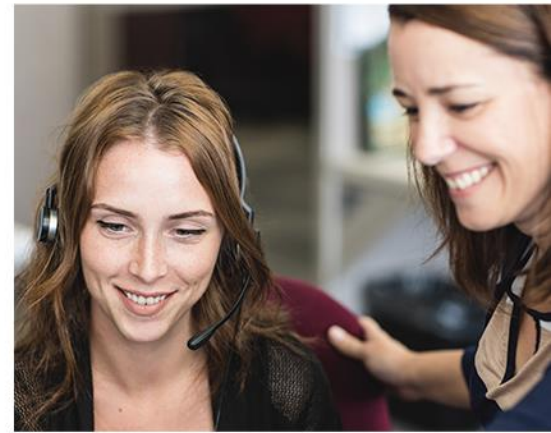
