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
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Highlights - opportunities to improve colorectal cancer (CRC) care delivery





- Standardization of CRC care: variation in CRC care delivery persists
- Patient-centric care: existing care pathways appear more healthcare provider-centric
- Value assessment: patient reported outcomes and cost-related data are being collected, to various degrees, by individual institutions
- COVID-19 pandemic: affected all aspects of CRC care pathway, but also led to quick transition to virtual care delivery.
